Announcing the 2nd Annual Tree and Shrub Sale

Last year was our first time offering this sale and we were gratified by the amazing response to it. In the process, we learned a lot and will be making a few changes so that you won't be disappointed by not getting the items that you wanted:

- **Earlier Deadline:** We moved the deadline up to December 15th. However, we will begin taking orders **immediately** and passing them on to our supplier. Orders are filled on a first come basis, so we **Strongly Encourage** you to **order early** so you won't be disappointed.
- **Most popular items:** These are the items that quickly sold-out last year
 - **Norway Spruce**
 - **White Pine**
 - **Red Pine**
 - **Order these items asap if you want them; they go quickly**

Now is a good time to sit back and think of ways to improve our properties. Not only can we

beautify our land, we can help to improve our watershed and ultimately, improve water quality. To that end, we're happy to offer you **bargain pricing** on trees and shrubs to enhance your lot. We have a fine selection of seedling-sized plants that, over time, will grow to full-size – all at a very economical price.

Order now and pick-up of the seedlings will be scheduled for a date in **late April or early May**, depending on weather conditions. The date, time and location will be communicated directly to you next spring. We'll provide you with a free fertilizer tab for each item ordered along with a planting instruction sheet. Additional fertilizer tabs can also be ordered. You may also want to consider ordering Root Gel – just mix it with 5 gallons of water and apply when you plant. The Root Gel will help to establish the seedling and get it off to a good start. Of course, further watering throughout the season will be needed. One ounce of Root Gel is also priced at just \$3.

All of our selections are native plants and over the upcoming years, will greatly enhance your property. Natives offer extensive root systems which in turn allow more rain to soak into our sandy soils and reduce runoff into the lakes. They also work as a filter to keep excess nutrients and pollutants out of our lakes. **You can make a difference for our lakes in your own backyard!** Now is the time to plan how you can add those deep roots to your yard.

Best of all, each item ordered is just \$3! There is no requirement to order an entire bundle of 25 plants – just order what you need for your property. At this price, quantities are limited, so first come, first served. Just complete the attached order form and submit it today!

Place your order now and plan to pick up in Rome late April or early May – date to be determined by Spring weather conditions and will be communicated to you. You will need to pick up on the specified date – if you cannot make it yourself, ask a friend or neighbor. Any items not picked up on the distribution date will not be reserved or refunded.

All individual seedlings will be sold at a flat rate of \$3 (what a bargain!) and will include a fertilizer tablet and planting instructions. Root gel (1 oz makes 5 gallons and helps plant establishment) is also available for purchase.
